TeraPlast shares strengthen their presence on the Stock Exchange and are promoted to the Premium category of the Bucharest Stock Exchange Main Market

- **TeraPlast, the largest polymer processor in South-Eastern Europe, is promoted to the Premium category of the Bucharest Stock Exchange (BVB) Main Market**
- **TeraPlast shares have been listed on the BVB since July 2008, under the ticker symbol TRP**
- **Currently, TeraPlast's market capitalization exceeds RON 1.4 billion**
- **TeraPlast is the second company on the BVB to have its shares promoted to the Premium category**
- **The promotion of TRP shares to the Premium category was intermediated by BRK Financial Group**

[TeraPlast](#) shares—part of the TeraPlast Group, a construction materials manufacturer with over 130 years of industrial tradition and listed on the Bucharest Stock Exchange ([BVB](#)) under the ticker symbol [TRP](#)—were promoted on Friday, March 13, from the Standard to the Premium category of the Main Market operated by the BVB.

A company's promotion to the Premium share category reflects the fulfillment of rigorous criteria regarding free-float market capitalization and share liquidity. TeraPlast has met these requirements—driven, among other factors, by the implementation of high standards of transparency and corporate governance—and is thus elevated to a superior tier. This evolution reaffirms TeraPlast's status as a representative company of the Romanian capital market and marks a new milestone in strengthening the company's presence on the Stock Exchange.

The inclusion of shares in the Premium category of the BVB Main Market brings a series of advantages for TeraPlast as an issuer, primarily related to enhanced visibility among both retail and institutional investors.

A broader presence of companies within the BVB Premium category serves as a direct indicator of the Romanian capital market's maturation. A more mature market also implies superior standards of communication and governance among issuers—essential elements for strengthening the confidence of both local and international investors.

TRP shares are included in the market's main index, BET, which tracks the largest and most liquid companies listed on the BVB, as well as in the BET-BK, BET-TR, BET-TRN, BET-XT, BET-XT-TR, BET-XT-TRN, and BETPlus indices. Furthermore, TeraPlast shares are included in the FTSE Russell Emerging Markets and FTSE Global All Cap indices, thereby gaining significant visibility among international investors. Its shares are also part of the MSCI Frontier Markets indices.

TeraPlast benefits from Issuer Market Making services provided by Raiffeisen Bank International AG since 2024, and by BRK Financial Group since 2020.

TeraPlast is the second company to have its shares promoted from the Standard to the Premium Category of the Regulated Market; the first issuer to achieve this promotion was the global aluminum producer ALRO in 2018. Out of the 87 companies currently listed on the BVB Main Market, the shares of 33 companies are included in the Premium category.

"At the BVB, companies become more performant, gaining visibility and prestige. We are pleased to witness the rise of TeraPlast, which has become an undisputed industry leader and ranks among the top construction materials producers in Central and Eastern Europe. The inclusion of TRP shares in the Main Market's Premium category is a natural step in the evolution of a company that has now reached a market capitalization of over RON 1.4 billion. Every issuer that moves to the Premium tier contributes to positioning Romania as a robust and trustworthy investment environment, reflecting the fact that the local capital market is maturing and becoming increasingly attractive to both Romanian and foreign investors," stated Remus Vulpescu, CEO of BVB.

"The promotion to the Bucharest Stock Exchange's Premium category confirms the operational performance, discipline, and vision with which we have built TeraPlast in recent years. This is a natural step in our capital market evolution and a validation of the strategy through which we have expanded the company beyond Romania's borders—with operations in the Republic of Moldova, Hungary, Croatia, and Austria—and our development plans do not stop here.

There are few companies listed on the Bucharest Stock Exchange that have succeeded in transforming themselves over time into Romanian-born multinationals, creating jobs in other countries and delivering competitive, locally manufactured products to European markets. This is the model we believe in and continue to develop.

The capital market remains a strategic partner for TeraPlast's growth, and our objective is to continue generating value for our shareholders through investment, operational efficiency, and business expansion," stated Dorel Goia, Chairman of the Board of Directors of TeraPlast.

The promotion to the Premium category was intermediated by BRK Financial Group, one of the most active intermediaries in the local capital market.

"The inclusion of TeraPlast in the Bucharest Stock Exchange's Premium category reflects a new milestone in the evolution and maturation of both the issuer and the Romanian capital market. Such promotions are significant as they contribute to consolidating the universe of representative companies and increasing the stock exchange's attractiveness to investors. About Bucharest Stock Exchange

BVB is the only securities market operator in Romania. On the two markets it manages – the Regulated Market and the Multilateral Trading System – a wide range of financial instruments are listed, such as stocks, bonds, fund units, 8 ETFs, certificates, structured products, and preferential rights. In 2025, the market capitalization of all companies listed on the BVB exceeded the threshold of RON 500 billion (EUR 100 million).

The BET Index, the main index of the Romanian capital market, which reflects the performance of the 20 most liquid companies listed on the BVB, reached 25,000 points, recording in 2025 the best performance of the past 16 years (+46%). In February 2026, BET exceeded 29.000 points.



In 2020, the Romanian capital market was recognized through its promotion to Emerging Market status by the global index provider FTSE Russell. Currently, 12 Romanian companies are included in FTSE Russell indices dedicated to emerging markets. In 2025, MSCI recognized the local capital market as an Advanced Frontier Market, marking a milestone on the path toward Romania obtaining Emerging Market status from MSCI.
